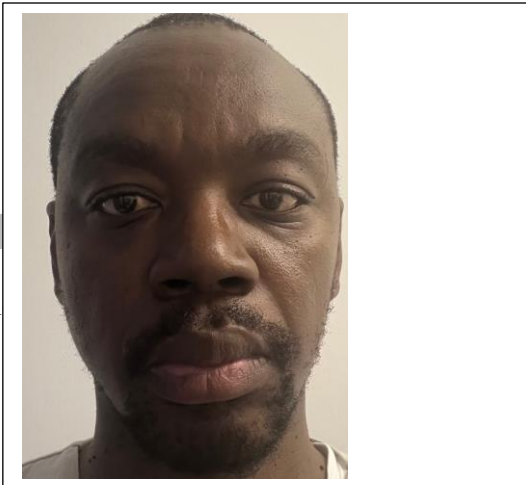
### ABSTRACT (upto 300 words)
